ADDITIONAL PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES IN RESPONSE TO ESCALATING GLOBAL COVID - 19 SITUATION.

Corona Virus

In view of the surge in the number of confirmed cases across Europe, the Singapore Ministry of Health (MOH) have put in place additional measures to limit the risk that visitors & returning travellers from some European countries pose to Singapore.

With effect from 15 March 2020, 2359 hours, the following measures will apply:

Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents or long-term pass holders, with travel history to France, Germany, Italy or Spain within the last 14 days, who enter Singapore, will be issued with a Stay-Home Notice (SHN).

Those, who are not Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents or long-term pass holders, with travel history to France, Germany, Italy or Spain within the last 14 days, will not be allowed entry into Singapore, or transit through Singapore.

Since 4 March 2020, flight and cabin crew entering Singapore and exhibiting fever and/or other symptoms of respiratory illness are required to undergo a COVID19 swab test at the checkpoint, regardless of travel history. With immediate effect, all such flight and cabin crew will be issued a 14-day SHN, which they will have to serve in full, even if the result of the swab test is negative. Those who meet the clinical suspect case definition will be conveyed to hospital for follow-up
